WEEK 2. PRESCREENS!




- Tips and tricks on filming the perfect prescreen!

WEEK 3. WEBSITE/ SOCIAL MEDIA/ HEADSHOTS!


- An online presence to share your material is crucial in the current theater world! Your website, social media accounts, and headshot should reflect your most authentic self!

- Audition outfit - (can be the same as your prescreen)


WEEK 7. MOCK AUDITION DAY!

- Songs first then monologues!




